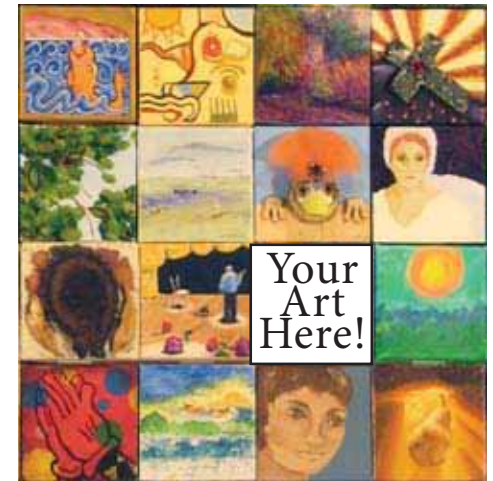

## INTRODUCTION

Once again the Racine Art Guild is stepping out into the community with an ambitious and exciting summer event, and you'll want to be part of it!

Sharing art with Racine is one of our stated missions, but we can do more in these challenging economic times. Our Art Squared event, "Food for the HeART" will do just that. Food nourishes the body and art nourishes the heart.

The subject of our six inch canvases will be food, and anything having to do with food. All the profits, including the \$10.00 canvas fee, and the \$20.00 purchase price of the finished canvases will go to food pantries in town, as well as any donated non-perishable food items collected at each showing beginning with the unveiling at the Starving Artist Fair on August 1 and the subsequent showings on the next three Saturdays August 7, 14, and 21 at the Farmers' Market on State St. in the CNH parking lot. Voting for the Peoples' Choice Awards will begin at the Starving Artist's Fair and continue the following three Saturdays at the Farmers' Market.

Only one hundred six inch canvases will be available and once again the completed works will form a five foot by five foot mosaic which will be displayed as outlined above. All submissions are to be non-collaborative and may be three-dimensional in the form of a low relief as long as the elements fit within the edges of the canvas. The work may be completed in any stable medium.



## GUIDELINES

- Any artist over 18 who resides in Racine County or is a member of Racine Art Guild is eligible to participate.
- The theme of the art exhibition is Food for the HeART.
- All artwork must be original and as long as it fits within the six inch square provided canvas be explored in any media, style, or form of expression appropriate for display.
- 3-D artwork may be permitted provided the 3-D component protrudes from the face of the canvas only. (The canvases will be fastened together tightly on all four sides of the frame for hanging).
- Each artist must submit a brief explanation pertaining to his or her artwork on a note card provided when canvases are distributed. This statement will be included with your artwork when purchased.
- Hanging and arranging of the individual works will be at the discretion of the Art<sup>2</sup> exhibit committee.
- Each completed canvas will be donated to Art<sup>2</sup> and therefore becomes the property of the RAG. However, each artist retains the copyright to his or her artwork if properly marked with the copyright symbol (©) next to the artist signature on the back of the canvas so the front remains anonymous.

## WHAT WE NEED FROM PARTICIPANTS

Any artist over 18 who resides in Racine County or is a member of Racine Art Guild may register. You will receive a blank canvas and a note card. You will write a brief statement (your name, why you picked this subject matter and the materials you used) that will be included with your completed canvas and go to the buyer of your art piece. Applications must be received by Thursday, April 8 and be accompanied by a registration form and a \$10 check made out to Racine Art Guild. Canvases will be available at the April 8th Art Guild meeting at Wustum at 6:30 pm or by calling Jim Chaplin at 638-9873 to get a canvas.

## PRIZES - People's Choice Awards & PURCHASING

During the month of August, beginning with the Starving Artist Fair and continuing for 3 Saturdays at The Farmers Market people may vote for their favorite ONE time only.

First Prize is \$250  
Second Prize is \$125  
Third Prize is \$75

Winners will be announced and awards presented on August 28 at noon at Monument Square.

Anyone can purchase one of the canvases for \$20! But which one? That's the fun. Throughout the duration of the exhibit, individuals will have the opportunity to purchase an artwork on display at The Farmers Market on State St in the CNH (Case) parking lot. Cash or checks made out to Racine Art Guild will be accepted. The artwork the purchaser eventually receives will be determined by a blind draw. Artists will sign the backs of the canvases and art will remain anonymous. The mystery will be revealed on August 28 when purchasers will pick up their canvas on Monument Square at the People's Choice Awards Presentation at noon.
